



BAND RULES AND INFORMATION

EVENT DETAILS

Date: 24th October, 2019

Venue: The Prince Bandroom, The Prince Hotel, 29 Fitzroy St, St Kilda

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

- Bands must consist entirely of employees of construction industry companies. Companies may combine in joint ventures to form bands.
- Maximum of 6 members / band.
- Bands will be expected to assist in promoting the event to their colleagues / clients / friends.
- Bands can play any style of music (nothing obscene please). Covers and original tunes are equally acceptable.
- Bands to submit a planned set list on application. Bands will be notified ASAP of any song clashes with other bands.
- All bands will receive an equal amount of time on stage. Each band is expected to perform for no longer than 15 minutes, unless otherwise instructed.
- Bands must provide a Band Bio covering experience as a band, how long it has been established, a short paragraph on each player/singer and provide a recent band photo/band image for the web site.
- All bands are required to send one band member to a pre-meeting before the event (date to be confirmed).

ENTRY FEE

- The minimum entry fee for each band is \$250 regardless of number of members in the band. This includes entry to the event, band member tickets and website company publicity.
- The payment of \$250 is required to confirm a place at the event should the entry fee not be paid within three weeks of entry confirmation; the position will be opened back up for later entries on a first come first served basis.

STAGE SETTING

- Back line (bass amp, guitar amp and drums only) will be available together with all PA and mics.
- Band members must provide all other musical instruments and equipment necessary for the performance.
- A stage crew will be on hand to assist each band in setting up and brief sound check. It is the band's responsibility to set gear and be ready to perform in the allotted time.
- Stage management has final say on all activities on stage.
- Any band going over the 15-minute limit, or disregarding event management's direction about anything, including safety and time, may be disqualified or powered off.
- Bands will be allotted a time between 3.00pm and 6.30pm (TBC) for sound checking on the day of the event which all band members must attend. Please note that

sound check time will not allow for a full run through of your bands performance. The time allowed will generally allow for run through of one song only.

- Bands may unload equipment from 3:00pm on the day of the event
- Bands must report to the stage manager at least one hour before their scheduled performance and remain on-site until the end of the event.
- All bands must be present for the announcement of the winners.

SECURITY

- Bands must adhere to the event's health and safety regulations and requirements at all times.
- Bands should arrange their own Public Liability insurance for themselves, their guests and their equipment.
- Band members are responsible for the security and insurance of their equipment.
- The event organisers cannot be held liable for any lost, damaged, or stolen equipment.
- Fires, pyrotechnics, fog machines etc. are not allowed.
- Only persons 18 or over will be admitted to the venue. No exceptions.

SCORING SYSTEM

- A panel of judges will score musicians using a point system. Prizes will be awarded.
- An audience vote will be cast. The weighting for the audience vote will be lower than the judges' scores.
- All ticket/door sale profits will be given to a charity nominated by the winning band.

COPYRIGHT

- The bands and the bands guests agree to the promoters recording and photographing the event and to them using any such material to promote future events, fund raising, web site, press, You Tube, etc.

The event organisers reserve the right to make changes to the rules and regulations of the contest as well as the final word in any disputes that should arise concerning the contest. Failure to comply with contest rules may result in bands being disqualified.
